ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES	<p>Centro Sávila is seeking an experienced, licensed clinician to work with adjudicated youth, ages 12-17 years old and their families. The CTI Clinician will work with a team of casework specialists to connect their patients and their families to resources (housing, food, transportation, childcare benefits, financial assistance, social services, educational opportunities, etc.). The ideal candidate will be familiar with trauma informed care and working in a team approach. CTI Clinician should also be bilingual (Spanish-English). Centro Sávila is a National Health Service Corps Site. Independently licensed clinicians applying for this position may be eligible for up to \$25,000/year reimbursement of Student Loans in addition to their salary.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides time-limited outpatient individual, family and group psychotherapy to CTI Program participants. • Work with Centro Sávila’s Critical Time Intervention Specialist team who provide case management and systems navigation directly with adjudicated youth and their families participating in an alternative sentencing to incarceration program. • Monitors and provides clinical supervision to CTI Specialists providing universal screening for Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and Pathways to a Healthy Bernalillo County Program for program participants. • Ensures adherence to the goals of time-limited CTI Intervention components, of strengthening participants’ long-term ties to services, family and friends and providing emotional and practical support during the transition. • Coordinates weekly case staffings and trainings for the CTI team on Critical Time Intervention, Trauma Informed Care, Adverse Childhood Experiences, Community Health Work, Motivational Interviewing, Social Determinants of Health and systems navigation. • Ensures timely and accurate reporting for CTI program in the Electronic Medical Record, Time and Effort logs and other program charts as required by Centro Sávila. • Ensures CTI Team documentation of systemic barriers that program participants face and participates in monthly Bernalillo County meetings for the ACEs program. • Participates in professional development and clinical trainings for staff and students. • Promotes excellent customer service systems, positive outcomes and participates in service evaluation. • Other duties as required.
